Description

Finding Paradise features objects selected from the holdings of numerous private collectors, many of which have never been seen by the public until now. They are discussed here in essays by both scholars and collectors. An extensively illustrated book that includes over 500 color images, Finding Paradise looks at period objects from Hawai'i's traditional, monarchical, territorial and early statehood eras. It features paintings and painters;

drawings; prints and printmakers; photographs and photographers; and "The Hawai'i one hundred" a list of essential books printed before the end of the nineteenth century chosen to represent the history of Hawaiian discovery and nationhood.
